This Month's Question and Answer:

Question: How can runway centerline stripes be used to measure or monitor takeoff and landing performance?

Answer: Runway centerline stripes are 120 feet long with an 80-foot gap between them. This makes a convenient visual reference for monitoring takeoff ground roll (200 feet from the beginning of one runway centerline stripe to the next) or landing distance.
